## **HALF DAY SPECIALS:**

- Crazy Creations: Put on your lab coats and get ready to experiment with all sorts of slimy, gooey stuff
  during this week! You will make slime, create explosions with soda, and create your own play-dough
  and more.
- **Bugs in Your Schoolyard**: Kids search for bugs, collect specimens, and submit observations to the iNaturalist biodiversity databank, which is used to help better understand and protect the natural world. Check out www.calacademy.org/science-action-club-sac or more info.
- Baking Bootcamp: Move beyond the basics and stretch your baking repertoire to include things like biscuits, muffins, cupcakes, fruit tarts, and dessert sauces. Students will also learn measurements and equivalents, as well as basic techniques like folding, whisking, and rolling during this week.
- **Birds in Your Schoolyard:** Youth investigate birds and document their discoveries in the eBird databank, which helps scientists better understand and protect these important species. Explore sample activities at www.calacademy.org/science-action-club-sac
